For amateurs and professionals, suppliers or end-users, the **Mondial de la Simulation** became THE annual meeting for this dynamic sector. The third edition is scheduled on **2008, November 28th, 29th and 30th**.

- **Location :** Le Bourget Air & Space Museum
- **Target :** European professionals and enthusiasts.

During 3 days, professionals take benefit of the museum fabulous context to display on their booth their latest innovations and products in simulation. This year event will particularly insist on simulated training and teaching for vehicles driving or in building, mechanics and engineering activities.

Installed in the 'Concorde Hall' (3000 sqm), the exhibition gives professional visitors and general public the opportunity to discover and test the more recent materials and software.

The available outdoor area – more than 50,000 m² - gives the possibility to make virtual becoming real by proposing visitors to drive 'in real' some of the vehicles they experimented on computer: military tanks, racing cars...

Forums and conferences will be held in the 350 seats auditorium (program in process).

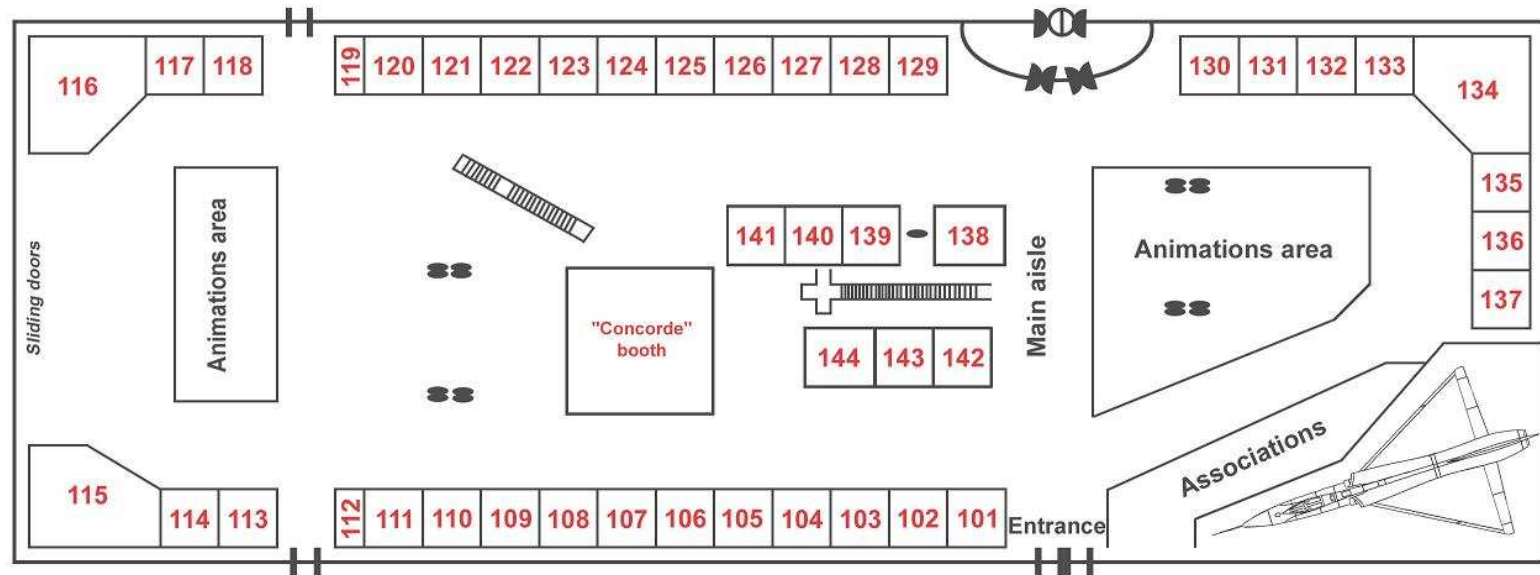
